PGIS RESEARCH GRANTS – 2026

The Postgraduate Institute of Science (PGIS), University of Peradeniya, invites applications for the PGIS Research Grants – 2026 from permanent academic staff and scientists associated with the PGIS from the University of Peradeniya or other institutions.

The grants are intended to support innovative research projects in science-based disciplines and to strengthen postgraduate research training through the involvement of MPhil and PhD students registered at the PGIS.

The maximum funding available is LKR 620,000 per grant per year, with the following maximum grant periods:

- MPhil: Two (2) years – up to LKR 1,240,000
- Direct PhD: Three (3) years – up to LKR 1,860,000
- MPhil upgraded to PhD: An additional one (1) year may be granted, subject to the approval of the PGIS Research Grant Committee.

Applicants are requested to carefully read the PGIS Research Grant Application Form – 2026 and the relevant guidelines for information on eligibility, funding conditions, eligible expenditure, progress monitoring, reporting requirements, publication and dissemination requirements, and other terms and conditions.

The completed application, together with **three separate copies of Section II and Section III**, and a **soft copy** submitted via email with the subject “PGIS RESEARCH GRANTS – 2026”, should reach the Director, Postgraduate Institute of Science (PGIS) on or before **30 October 2026**.
