CALLING FOR ABSTRACTS

The Postgraduate Institute of Science is proud to present the 10th PGIS Research Congress, 'RESCON 2026'. The Research Congress is an ideal platform for researchers to share their findings, and to open avenues for new innovation and collaboration. Authors are invited to submit their original work to be presented at the Research Congress through the official website

<http://www.pgis.lk/rescon2026>. Authors should submit their abstracts via the Microsoft CMT submission system of the website. Submissions will be subjected to a blind review process.

ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

Complete submissions should include:

1. A duly filled submission form
2. Blind abstract (not including author names)
3. Blind extended abstract
4. Author declaration form
5. Author checklist

Details of ALL AUTHORS must be added to the "Authors" section of the submission page, and the corresponding author should be indicated. The Editorial Board reserves the right to change the Theme of the abstract identified by the authors to a more relevant Theme, if necessary. Results presented or published elsewhere will not be considered.

The abstract should include an introductory sentence or two, objectives, methods, results, discussion (if applicable) and conclusions of the study. If accepted, abstracts will be published in the 'Proceedings of the Postgraduate Institute of Science Research Congress 2026'. Detailed guidelines on abstract preparation and formatting is available at the congress website.

Extended abstract: This is MANDATORY for reviewing. The formatting of the extended abstract should be similar to that of the abstract, giving priority to the results and discussion, within 2-3 pages. Figures and tables should be clearly presented and be included within the stipulated page limits. For detailed guidelines please visit the congress website.

CAMERA READY SUBMISSIONS

- Once accepted, abstracts along with reviewer comments will be shared with the authors.
- Authors must submit a final camera-ready version, including all suggested changes.
- Detailed guidelines for the camera-ready format will be provided after acceptance.
- At least one author must present the accepted abstract.
- If no author is available, the authors must inform the Editorial Board or take appropriate action.
- If the abstract is not presented, the authors will be banned from submitting to the PGIS Research Congress for three years.
